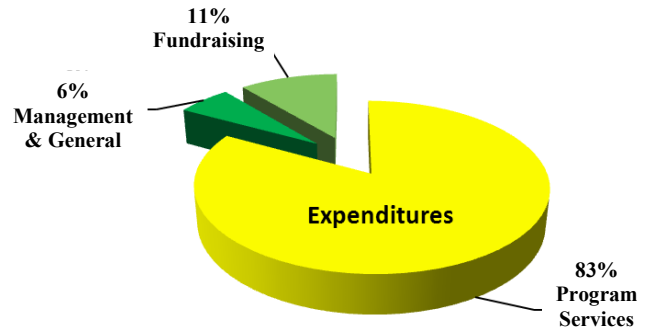

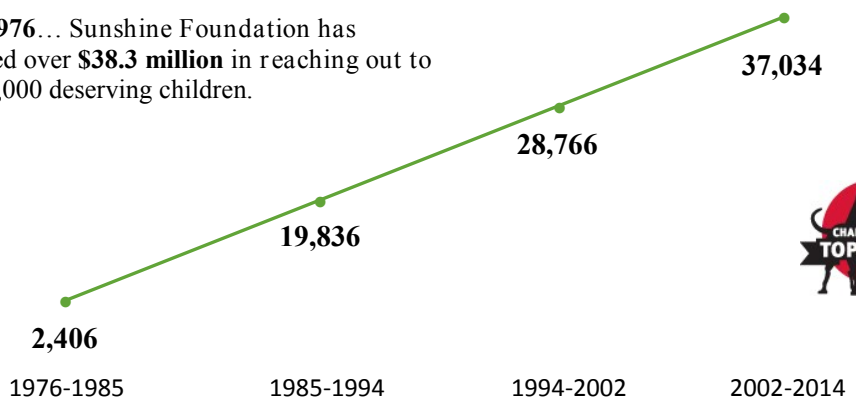
Sunshine Foundation Dreamlifts

This is a way of giving groups of chronically ill, physically challenged and abused children that special day in their favorite Central Florida theme park. Children board the plane in the morning and just a few hours later they are enjoying a day that will mean tons of fun and exciting memories.
